INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT SUNDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2003 – 0800 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 3

CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationwide. Nationally 41 new fires were reported. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in Arizona, California, Hawaii and Utah.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA LARGE FIRES:

PARADISE 2, Sequoia & Kings Canyon National Park. This wildland fire, previously reported as part of the Kaweah-Kern Complex, is in mixed conifer and chaparral, seven miles northeast of Three Rivers, CA. Active burning along ridge tops and drainages was observed. Crews are constructing direct and indirect handline with helicopter support.
