## INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SITUATION REPORT WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2005 – 0530 MDT NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS LEVEL 2

## CURRENT SITUATION:

Initial attack activity was light nationally with 40 new fires reported. No new large fires were reported. Very high to extreme fire indices were reported in California, Nebraska, South Dakota, Wyoming and Arizona.

Presidential Disaster Declarations have been issued for Hurricanes Katrina, Rita and Wilma in Mississippi, Alabama, Louisiana, Texas and Florida. An Area Command Team (Williams-Rhodes) is coordinating relief operations in Louisiana and Texas (FEMA Region VI). The Marietta Mobilization Center in Marietta, GA continues to house and in-brief resources prior to assignment.

# SOUTHERN AREA INCIDENTS / LARGE FIRES:

HURRICANES KATRINA AND RITA SUPPORT, Federal Emergency Management Agency. Emergency Support Function (ESF) #4 at the state Emergency Operations Centers in Jackson, MS and Baton Rouge, LA are staffed.

Five Type 2 Incident Management Teams (Morcom, Goheen, Floyd, Carlson and LaFave) are assigned.

Morcom: managing base camps at Gulfport and Vancleave, MS. Preparation to demobilize Vancleave Camp is in progress.

Goheen: managing a mobilization center and base camp at Camp Beauregard, near Pineville, LA.

Floyd: managing a receiving and distribution center at Barskdale Air Force Base, Bossier City, LA.

Carlson: managing the Jackson Support Base in the New Orleans French Quarter and supporting several satellite camps in southern Louisiana.

LaFave: supporting receiving and distribution sites in Hancock County from Stennis Space Center, MS. Points of distribution are now under management of local personnel.

HURRICANE WILMA SUPPORT, Federal Emergency Management Agency. The Regional Response Coordination Center is currently staffed in Atlanta, GA. An Emergency Operations Center is staffed in Tallahassee, FL.

Two Type 1 Incident Management Teams (Pincha-Tulley and Gelobter) are assigned.

Gelobter: managing the Jacksonville Operational Staging Area at Jacksonville, FL, and the receiving and distributing of relief supplies.

Pincha-Tulley: is assigned to Homestead, FL, to manage a base camp and receiving and distribution center.

RICE, Texas Forest Service. This fire started on private land 25 miles northwest of Houston, TX, in pine and hardwood forest. No new information was reported.
