Sweat Farm Road, Georgia Forestry Commission. North Carolina IMT 2 (Hildreth). IMT also managing the Bugaboo Scrub 2, Roundabout Swamp and Knee Knocker Swamp fires. Started on private land ten miles west of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Running, torching and short range spotting. Residences and sensitive species habitat remain threatened.

Big Turnaround Complex, Okefenokee NWR. IMT 1 (Oltrogge). Ten miles southeast of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Active fire behavior. Structures, historic sites and recreation facilities remain threatened.

BICY Complex (five fires), Big Cypress National Preserve. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (Stanich) to IMT 1 (Whitney) on 5/27. Fifty-one miles west of Ft. Lauderdale, FL. Southern rough. Fire behavior moderated. Mandatory evacuation of a portion of the Preserve remains in effect.

Florida Bugaboo, National Forests in Florida. Unified Command between NIMO (Ferguson) and Florida IMT 2 (Beauchamp). Baker County, FL. Southern rough. Ground fire. Numerous structures remain threatened.

Bugaboo Scrub 2, Georgia Forestry Commission. Started on private land five miles east of Fargo, GA. Southern rough and timber. Smoldering with isolated torching.

Stag Road, North Carolina DOF. Five miles north of Hampstead, NC. North Carolina IMT 2 (Hendricks). Brush and slash. Smoldering and creeping.

Deland Complex (five fires), Florida DOF. Six miles west of Ormond Beach. Southern rough. Active burning in swamp.

Dairy Road, Florida DOF. Seven miles northwest of Keystone Heights, FL. Southern rough. Reburning and flare-ups. Numerous structures remain threatened.

Buck Shank, Great Smoky Mountains NP. Ten miles south of Maryville, TN. Hardwood litter. Active fire behavior.

Joe Lewis, National Forests in North Carolina. Seven miles south of Erwin, TN. Minimal fire behavior. Historical town threatened.

Paterson, Florida DOF. Eighteen miles east of Lehigh Acres, FL. Southern rough. Extreme fire behavior. Evacuation in effect.

Jinx, Florida DOF. Two miles northwest of Kendall West, FL. Tall grass. Rapid rates of spread with spotting.

Pigeon Branch, Cherokee National Forest. Two miles east of Cedar Creek, TN. Hardwood litter. Moderate fire behavior with spotting.

Callaway Height, Florida DOF. Eight miles northeast of Callaway, FL. Southern rough. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.
