**Big Turnaround Complex**, Okefenokee NWR. IMT 1 (Ruggiero). Ten miles southeast of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Minimal fire activity. Numerous structures, historic sites and recreation facilities remain threatened.

**Sweat Farm Road**, Georgia Forestry Commission. North Carolina IMT 2 (Hildreth). IMT also managing the Bugaboo Scrub 2 fire. Started on private land 10 miles west of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Smoldering and creeping.

**BICY Complex** (four fires), Big Cypress National Preserve. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (Whitney) back to the local unit on 6/5. Fifty-one miles west of Ft. Lauderdale, FL. Southern rough. Minimal fire activity.

**Okeechobee Complex** (three fires), Florida DOF. Eight miles southwest of Okeechobee, FL. Grass. Residences remain threatened. No further information received.

**Bugaboo Scrub 2**, Georgia Forestry Commission. Previously reported. Started on private land four miles east of Fargo, GA. Southern rough and timber. Minimal fire activity.

**Deland Complex** (seven fires), Florida DOF. Six miles west of Ormond Beach. Southern rough. Active interior burning. Residences remain threatened.

**Dairy Road**, Florida DOF. Seven miles northwest of Keystone Heights, FL. Southern rough. Increased interior burning. Numerous structures threatened.

**Copperhead**, Florida DOF. Eleven miles west of Miami Gardens, FL. Grass. Running fire. Structure threatened.

Middle of Nowhere, Florida DOF. Fifteen miles northeast of Ft. Myers, FL. Southern rough. Interior smoldering.

Buck Shank, Great Smoky Mountains NP. Ten miles south of Maryville, TN. Hardwood litter. Minimal fire activity.
