Big Turnaround Complex, Okefenokee NWR. IMT 1 (Ruggiero). Ten miles southeast of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures, historic sites and recreation facilities remain threatened. Reburning remains a problem. Reduction in acreage due to elimination of double-reporting with Sweat Farm Road.

Sweat Farm Road, Georgia Forestry Commission. Georgia IMT 2 (Floyd). Ten miles west of Waycross, GA. Southern rough and timber. Creeping and smoldering. Reburning remains a problem.

BICY Complex, Big Cypress National Preserve. Fifty-one miles west of Ft. Lauderdale, FL. Southern rough. No further information received.

Okeechobee Complex (three fires), Florida DOF. Eight miles southwest of Okeechobee, FL. Grass. Smoldering. Monitoring by aircraft.

Dairy Road, Florida DOF. Seven miles northwest of Keystone Heights, FL. Southern rough. Increased burning and smoldering in interior. Reburning remains a problem.

Deland Complex (seven fires), Florida DOF. Six miles west of Ormond Beach. Southern rough. Actively burning in swamps. Reburning remains a problem.

Middle of Nowhere, Florida DOF. Fifteen miles northeast of Ft. Myers, FL. Southern rough. Minimal fire activity.
