Area Command Team (Zimmerman) is assigned to assist the Northern Rockies in analyzing assessments for long duration fires and emerging incidents.

Meriwether, Helena NF. IMT 1 (Bennett). IMT 1 (Oltrogge) ordered. Bennett is also managing the Ahorn fire. Thirty-seven miles northwest of Helena, MT. Timber, shrubs and grass. Extreme fire behavior with isolated torching. Structures remain threatened. Evacuations remain in effect.

Mile Marker 124, Southwestern Land Office, Montana DNR. IMT 2 (Angell). Nineteen miles southeast of Missoula, MT. Timber and grass. Surface fire with group tree torching. Traffic restrictions on I-90 in effect. Structures, power lines, communication towers remain threatened. Evacuations remain in effect.

Skyland, Flathead NF. IMT 2 (LaFave). Forty-five miles east of Whitefish, MT. Timber and understory litter. Short crown runs with isolated torching. Structures remain threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Ahorn, Lewis and Clark NF. Thirty miles west of Augusta, MT. Active fire behavior with crowning and group tree torching. Structures remain threatened. Evacuations remain in effect.

Poe Cabin, Craig Mountain Area Office, Idaho Department of Lands. IMT 1 (Stanich). Twenty-three miles southwest of Grangeville, ID. Timber, understory and grass. Isolated torching and creeping. Structures threatened.

Sawmill Complex (three fires), Lolo NF. IMT 2 (Heintz). Includes previously reported as Sawmill Creek, Wyman #2 and Fisher Point fires. Twenty-two miles southeast of Missoula, MT. Timber. Active fire behavior with isolated torching. Numerous structures remain threatened.

Rattlesnake, Nez Perce NF. IMT 2 (Secrest). IMT is also managing the Concord fire. Twenty-five miles south of Elk City, ID. Timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with short crown runs, spotting and torching. Two communities remain threatened.

Concord, Nez Perce NF. Twenty miles southwest of Elk City, ID. Timber litter. Moderate fire behavior, torching and spotting.

Garceau, Flathead Agency, BIA. IMT 2 (Grant). Fifty-five miles south of Whitefish, MT. Timber and grass. Active burning, isolated torching and creeping. Power lines and structures remain threatened.

Bridge, Clearwater NF. Forty-five miles southwest of Missoula, MT. Includes previously reported Hidden WFU. Timber. Moderate fire behavior, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Area closures remain in effect.

Brush Creek, Flathead NF. IMT 2 (Koehler). Twenty-five miles west of Whitefish, MT. Timber and understory. Active crowning and long-range spotting. Structures threatened.

Owl, Yellowstone NP. IMT 2 (Wilder). Forty-five miles south of Bozeman, MT. Timber and grass. Smoldering. Structures remain threatened.

Fool Creek, Lewis and Clark NF. FUMT (Hall). Thirty miles northwest of Choteau, MT. Timber and snags. Active fire behavior with short crown runs and isolated torching.

Pattengail Creek, Beaverhead/Deerlodge NF. Ten miles northeast of Wisdom, MT. Timber. Active fire behavior with torching and spotting.

Chimney Complex, Craig Mountain Area Office, Idaho Department of Lands. Transfer of command from IMT 2 (Kusicko) back to local unit today. Nineteen miles south of Lewiston, ID. Timber and grass. Smoldering.

Porcupine, Gallatin NF. Thirty-one miles north of Livingston, MT. Timber. Torching and smoldering.

Conger Creek, Lolo NF. Twenty miles north of Ovando, MT. Timber. Torching with short crown runs. Structures remain threatened.

Chippy Creek, Northwestern Land Office, Montana DNR. IMT 2 ordered. Forty-two miles southwest of Kalispell, MT. Timber and understory. Extreme fire behavior with crowning and running. Structures threatened.

Rombo Mountain, Bitterroot NF. Eighteen miles south of Darby, MT. Timber and understory. Crown fire with long-range spotting.

Lizard, Nez Perce NF. Fifty miles west of Hamilton, MT. Brush. Torching and long-range spotting. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

Chain, Nez Perce NF. Twenty miles southwest of Powell, ID. Timber and understory. Creeping. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.
