Texas Winter Fires 2008, Texas Forest Service. IMT 2 (Hannemann). Multiple Texas counties. IMT supporting numerous fires throughout west Texas.

County Line, Anadarko Agency, BIA. Four miles southwest of Cyril, OK. Timber and grass. Running, torching and spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuation order in effect.

Archer County, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land two miles southwest of Archer City, TX. Brush and grass. Isolated interior torching. Evacuation order lifted.

Glass, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land five miles southwest of Sterling City, TX. Brush and grass. Rapid rates of spread with isolated torching.

Silver, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land three miles southwest of Silver, TX. Brush and grass. Creeping and smoldering.

Rowden, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land twenty miles southeast of Abilene, TX. Brush and grass. Creeping and smoldering.

Commanche Ranch, Texas Forest Service. Twelve miles west of Carrizo Springs, TX. Grass. Creeping and smoldering with short runs.

Troy, Texas Forest Service. Sixteen miles southeast of Archer City, TX. Grass. Interior creeping and smoldering.

Gillett, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land four miles east of Gillett, TX. Grass. Creeping and smoldering.

Pedernales Falls II, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land 12 miles northeast of Johnson City, TX. Brush and grass. Creeping and smoldering with short runs.

Soggy Bottom, Wewoka Agency, BIA. Five miles west of Sasakwa, OK. Hardwood litter and grass. Creeping and smoldering.

650, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land twenty-four miles southwest of Austin, TX. Brush and grass. No further information received.

West Hackberry, Texas Forest Service. Started on private land eighteen miles west of Rock Springs, TX. Brush and grass. No new information.
