**Mustang Corner**, Everglades NP. IMT 1 (Quesinberry). Fifteen miles southwest of Kendall, FL. Grass. Smoldering.

**Brevard Complex** (6 fires), Florida DOF. Florida IMT 2 (Beauchamp). Brevard County, FL. Southern rough. Smoldering.

**Childress Ranch,** Texas Forest Service. IMT 2 (Hannemann). IMT is also managing the Juno fire. Twenty-two miles south of Ozona, TX. Chaparral, grass and cedar. Wind-driven fire activity with occasional torching and short-range spotting.

**Myakka Cut**, Florida DOF. Five miles north of Clewiston, FL. Grass. Minimal fire activity. Trace amounts of precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Mud Swamp New River,** National Forests in Florida. Five miles northeast of Sumatra, FL. Southern rough. Occasional torching with short-range spotting.

**Browntown,** Georgia Forestry Commission. Three miles northeast of Atkinson, GA. Southern rough. Crown fire with torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Voluntary evacuations in effect.

**Juno**, Texas Forest Service. Ten miles south of Juno, TX. Grass, juniper and cedar. Minimal fire behavior. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.
