Tanana Area Fires (9 fires), Tanana Zone, BLM. IMT 2 (Staats). Started on native corporation land seven miles northeast of Tanana, AK. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with group torching. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

Middle Yukon Fires (4 fires), Galena Zone, BLM. IMT 2 (Hutton). Started on native corporation land two miles north of Nulato, AK. Timber, brush and short grass. Active fire behavior with isolated torching, flanking and backing. Numerous structures threatened.

Rock, Tanana Zone, BLM. Started on native corporation land nine miles southeast of Hughes, AK. Timber. Active fire behavior with torching and backing. Structures threatened.

Chahalie Lake, Upper Yukon Zone, BLM. Started on native corporation land 10 miles northeast of Chalkyitsik, AK. Timber. Active fire behavior with crowning, running and smoldering.

Predictive Services Discussion Cooler, fall-like weather will spread southward to the central Rockies and central Plains as a strong Canadian cold front drops deeper into the U.S. Rain and thunderstorms will form along and ahead of a front from eastern Colorado to the upper Great Lakes region. Scattered thunderstorms will form over the Rockies and parts of the Great Basin as the upper ridge continues to weaken. Scattered afternoon thunderstorms will continue across the Southeast. Temperatures in the West will drop slightly with some warming beginning in the Pacific Northwest. The South will remain very warm while milder conditions continue in the Northeast.

In Alaska, high pressure will strengthen over the state, increasing temperatures and accelerating drying through the Interior. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop over the Southwest.
