Predictive Services Discussion: The strong, hot ridge of high pressure will continue to allow for monsoonal moisture to filter northward across the West. Scattered showers and wet storms are expected across the Southwest while a mix of scattered wet and dry storms are expected across the Great Basin and Northern Rockies. The Mid-Atlantic States and the New England will remain mostly warm and dry while the Southeast remains mostly wet beneath a stalled front. In Alaska, scattered showers and storms are possible along the Arctic Coast and across the interior. Other locations should be warm and dry.
