Nationally, there are 65 large fires being managed under a strategy other than full suppression.

Two hundred thirty-three soldiers from the 14<sup>th</sup> Brigade Engineer Batallion based out of Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington are deployed in support of the Mendocino Complex.

One hundred thirty-eight fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the California and Northwest Areas.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 152nd Airlift Wing (Nevada Air National Guard), and one from the 146th Airlift Wing (California Air National Guard) have been deployed to McClellan Airfield, CA in support of wildland fire operations.

One RC-26 aircraft with Distributed Real-Time Infrared (DRTI) capability and support personnel from the 141st Air Refueling Wing (Washington Air National Guard) has been deployed to Spokane, WA in support of wildland fire operations in the West.

**Ramsey Canyon,** Medford Unit, DOF. ODF IMT 1 (Hessel) mobilizing. Twelve miles north of Eagle Point, OR. Timber, chaparral and short grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and single tree torching. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

**Crescent Mountain**, Okanogan/Wenatchee NF. IMT 1 (Wilkins). IMT is also managing the McLeod and Holman incidents. Eighteen miles west of Winthrop, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with isolated torching and backing. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, road, area and trail closures in effect.

**McLeod**, Okanogan/Wenatchee NF. Eight miles north of Mazama, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with torching, short crown runs and spotting. Numerous residences threatened.

**Holman,** Okanogan/Wenatchee NF. Nineteen miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Watson Creek**, Fremont-Winema NF. IMT 2 (Sheldon). Thirteen miles west of Paisley, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with group torching, short crown runs and long-range spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Cougar Creek,** Okanogan/Wenatchee NF. IMT 1 (Livingston). IMT is also managing the Bannock Lakes incident. Twelve miles northwest of Ardenvoir, WA. Timber, medium logging slash and closed timber litter. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Numerous structures threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Bannock Lakes**, Okanogan/Wenatchee NF. Fourteen miles southwest of Stehekin, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior. Trail closures in effect.

**Terwilliger,** Williamette NF. IMT 2 (Sinclair). Five miles southeast of Blue River, OR. Timber. Active fire behavior with running, spotting and group torching. Numerous structures threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Boyds**, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. IMT 2 (Rabe). Three miles west of Kettle Falls, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, isolated torching and flanking. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened.

**Jennie's Peak 1039 RN**, Central Oregon Rangeland Protection Association. IMT 2 (Knerr). IMT is also managing the Stubblefield 1008 RN and Lonerock 1057 RN incidents. Fourteen miles south of Fossil, OR. Timber, brush and tall grass. Moderate fire behavior with torching, smoldering and creeping. Residences threatened.

**Stubblefield 1008 RN**, Oregon Private Lands. Started on private land seven miles west of Condon, OR. Timber, brush and short grass. Minimal fire behavior.

**Lonerock 1057 RN**, South Gilliam County Rural Fire Protection District. Eight miles southeast of Condon, OR. Timber, brush and short grass. Minimal fire behavior.

**Natchez,** Rogue River-Siskiyou NF. IMT 2 (Gales). Fifteen miles southeast of Cave Junction, OR. Timber and chaparral. Moderate fire behavior with backing, torching and flanking. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Horns Mountain**, Colville NF. Transfer of command from IMT 2 (Goff) back to the local unit will occur on 8/28. Nineteen miles north of Evans, WA. Timber and heavy logging slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing, torching and smoldering. Residences threatened.

**Taylor Creek**, Medford District, BLM. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (T. Kurth) to IMT 2 (Harrod) will occur today. IMT is also managing the Klondike incident. Ten miles west of Grants Pass, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior. Numerous structures threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Klondike,** Rogue River-Siskiyou NF. IMT 1 (J. Kurth). Nine miles northwest of Selma, OR. Timber and chaparral. Active fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and backing. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Miriam**, Okanogan/Wenatchee NF. IMT 2 (Johnson). Fifteen miles east of Packwood, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Miles,** Umpqua NF. IMT 1 (Schulte). IMT is also managing the Columbus incident. Five miles northeast of Trail, OR. Timber. Active fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Columbus,** Umpqua NF. Fifteen miles east of Tiller, OR. Timber. Active fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Road and area closures in effect.

**Hendrix,** Rogue River-Siskiyou NF. Nine miles southwest of Ashland, OR. Timber and medium logging slash. No new information.

**Kinzua Complex,** John Day Unit, DOF. Twelve miles east of Fossil, OR. Timber, brush and short grass. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.

**187 Gilman,** Umatilla NF. Twelve miles northeast of Monument, OR. Timber and short grass. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.

**Skyline,** Vale District, BLM. Fifteen miles south of Ironside, OR. Timber and brush. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.

**Stone,** Modoc NF. IMT 2 (Dalrymple). Fourteen miles northwest of Adin, CA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures, energy and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Mendocino Complex**, Mendocino Unit, Cal Fire. Unified Command between Cal Fire IMT 1 (Kavanaugh) and IMT 1 (von Tillow). Five miles south of Potter Valley, CA. Brush, hardwood slash and tall grass. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and backing. Numerous structures, energy and communication infrastructure threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect. Evacuations have been lifted.

**Hirz**, Shasta-Trinity NF. IMT 2 (Coots). IMT 1 (Young) mobilizing. Eleven miles east of Lakehead, CA. Timber and chaparral. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and running. Structures threatened. Road and area closures in effect. Evacuations have been lifted.

**South Sugarloaf**, Elko County Fire Protection District. IMT 2 (Rohrer). IMT1 (Lund) mobilizing. Twenty miles southwest of Owyhee, NV. Brush and grass. Extreme fire behavior with running, flanking and torching. Numerous structures, energy infrastructure and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect.

**County Line,** Nevada Division of Forestry – Northern Region, DOF. Five miles south of Carlin, NV. Brush and short grass. Active fire behavior with running, backing and creeping. Structures, energy infrastructure and sage-grouse habitat threatened.

**Stewart Creek,** Sawtooth NF. Eighteen miles northwest of Fairfield, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching, running and long-range spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened.

**Rabbit Foot**, Salmon-Challis NF. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (DeMasters) to IMT 2 (Roide) will occur today. Fourteen miles southwest of Salmon, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and spotting. Numerous structures, communication infrastructure and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Evacuations, road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Goshute Cave,** Ely District Office, BLM. Fifty-five miles north of Ely, NV. Timber, hardwood slash and dormant brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, uphill runs and short-range spotting. Structures and sagegrouse habitat threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect. Last narrative report unless significant activity occurs.

**Coal Hollow,** Manti-Lasal NF. IMT 2 (Fry). Fifteen miles southeast of Spanish Fork, UT. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, road, area and trail closures in effect.

**Mesa,** Payette NF. Four miles south of Council, ID. Timber, brush and tall grass. Minimal fire behavior. Sagegrouse habitat threatened. Road, area and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion: Temperatures across the Pacific Northwest and Northern California will begin to cool, as an unseasonably strong upper level trough begins to dip south from British Columbia. Along the base of the system, breezy winds are possible across Northern California and Nevada. Further south, southwesterly on-shore flow will keep temperatures near normal across Southern California. Inland, scattered wet monsoonal convection will continue across the Four Corners, as a breezy westerly flow continues across the Northern Rockies and the northern Great Plains. Across the East, near average conditions are expected due to the presence of a weak but broad trough over the Ohio River Valley and the Northeast. Across the South, the strong high pressure ridge over Texas will drift east, keeping conditions hot and humid. Isolated storms are expected across the Deep South in the afternoon.

### What the SAFECOM system IS

The Aviation Safety Communiqué (SAFECOM) AMD-34/FS-5700-14 should be used to report any condition, observation, act, maintenance problem, or circumstance with personnel or the aircraft that has the potential to cause an aviation-related mishap. SAFECOMS are a tool used to identify, document, track, and correct safety related issues.

### What the SAFECOM system IS NOT

- NOT intended for initiating punitive actions,
- NOT to be used as a complaint system or for personal attacks,
- NOT used by contracting officers for contract evaluations/award purposes,
- NOT a substitute for "on-the-spot" corrections to a safety concern, and
- Does NOT replace the requirement for initiating an accident or incident report.

### SAFECOMs provide the necessary feedback for development of the following communication tools:

- Accident Prevention Bulletins
- Lessons Learned
- Safety Alerts
- Technical Bulletins
- Airwards
- Information sharing Memos
- Maintenance deficiencies (ADs, SBs, etc)
- Safety trends
- Training needs
